

This southeast-facing fully furnished, bright 3-bedroom apartment, with a balcony, parking, and views of the Lesser Carpathians, is on the 4th floor of the Karpatium Residence located in Záhorská Bystrica, providing a peaceful, quiet environment as well as full civic amenities.

The layout of the apartment consists of an entrance hall with **custom-made** storage spaces, a living room with a kitchen and dining area with access to the **balcony**, a bedroom with a **wardrobe**, two additional rooms, a bathroom with a bathtub, shower, and toilet, and another separate toilet.

Facilities include **aluminum windows** with insulating triple glazing, **exterior electric aluminum blinds**, **wooden parquet floors**, **underfloor heating** or **fan coil cooling**. The kitchen is equipped with a bar area with a **wine fridge**, **two built-in refrigerators** with a freezer, a **dishwasher**, a hob, a microwave oven, and an oven.

The project has an impressive architecture and high-standard building materials, but also beautiful green inner courtyard, which includes a children's playground and a workout zone. Cafes, restaurants, shops, groceries, as well as an elementary school or kindergarten are in the immediate vicinity. The landscape of the Lesser Carpathians is within walking distance and offers opportunities for hiking or cycling.

The apartment also includes a **cellar** with an area of 2.6 m² and 2 **large** garage spaces for an additional fee.
