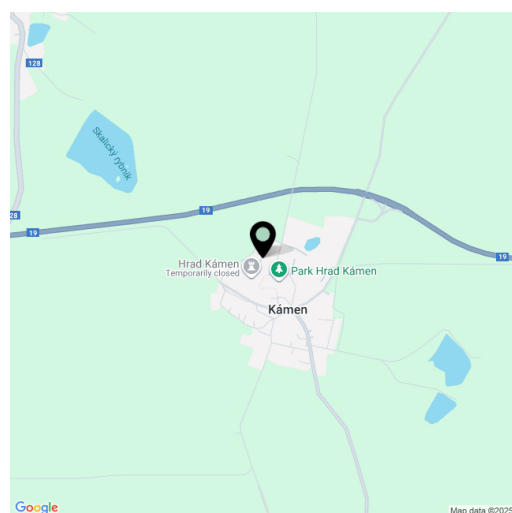

This stylish cottage in a romantic setting beneath the historic Kámen Castle, in the village of Kámen (Pelhřimov District, Vysočina Region), offers facilities for both recreation and permanent living. Originally a small agricultural homestead over 150 years old, it has preserved the charm of traditional rural architecture and includes a main building with three rooms, a spacious barn, and a separate guest house.

The interior of the main house features a living area with a dining section and fully equipped kitchen, three bedrooms, two bathrooms with showers, and a separate toilet. The converted barn offers a space used as a **summer cinema**, while the mature garden includes a terrace with seating, a firepit, and a swimming pool. **Parking spaces** are available directly on the property.

The property, located within **the protective zone of Kámen Castle**, was completely renovated in 2022 (with the exception of the roof). Windows are wooden; floors have durable tiles; heating is provided by **underfloor heating** and a stove connected to an electric boiler.

The picturesque region once home to **the poet Antonín Sova** offers numerous opportunities for hiking and cycling, enchanting anyone seeking the **authenticity of the Czech countryside**. The area is also exceptionally rich in honest **local products and traditional crafts**: a **family microbrewery** operates in Pacov, a **dairy** in Pošná produces homemade yogurts, curd, and cheeses, and Cětovaz is known for its goat milk delicacies. Thanks to convenient connections to the **D1 and D3 highways**, the village of Kámen is easily accessible from Prague, Brno, and České Budějovice.
